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INSTRUCTIONS FOR WORKING WITH THE GODDESS GUIDANCE ORACLE CARDS

The *Goddess Guidance Oracle Cards* will help you give accurate readings for yourself and others. Oracle cards are ancient, time-tested divination tools that allow you to see into the future. They're based on the Law of Magnetic Attraction, in which cards are attracted to a person's current thoughts and beliefs. Because your thoughts and beliefs create your future, the cards provide insight into the direction of relationships, careers, finances, health, and other areas.

There are no frightening cards in this deck, as they reflect the loving, nurturing style of the goddesses depicted on each card. Goddesses are an ancient aspect of spirituality and religion that incorporate the feminine nature of the Creator. In the West, Mother Mary is undoubtedly the most famous goddess, but this card deck will also introduce you to other goddesses



who would love to assist you in every area of your life. Goddesses work “hand-in-wing” with the angels, and come from both ancient and modern cultures and religions, including the Greek, Roman, Egyptian, Mayan, African, Christian, Tibetan, and Buddhist affiliations.

By working with the goddesses, you heal and empower your own inner feminine wisdom, which is within every woman and man. Your intuition is awakened, allowing you to be even more psychic. The goddesses also clear and open your heart chakra, which results in increased manifestation abilities. As we all awaken our own inner feminine power, our world becomes more balanced, and we move away from the old patriarchal monopoly. Goddess energy also renews our appreciation and respect for Mother Nature and supports the new highly sensitive children (known as Indigo, Crystal, and Rainbow Children).

Consecrating Your Card Deck

Your oracle cards must be cleared of prior energies and imbued with your personal intentions in order for them to operate at their



most efficient levels. If you ever find your card readings becoming “muddy” with unclear messages, be sure to reconsecrate the cards. It’s also important to conduct this process with new decks of cards and after other people touch your cards. Consecration clears away the energies of others, as well as fearful energy. Once you consecrate your cards, they’ll operate as an extension of you, and help you give accurate readings you can rely upon.

First, determine which is your dominant hand. For most people, this is the hand you write with. However, if you were born left-handed and were forced to switch to right-handedness, then your left hand is still your dominant hand, which *sends* energy. Hold the stack of your cards in the *other* hand, which is your nondominant, receptive hand, which *receives* energy.

Form a fist with your dominant hand and tap your knuckles once firmly on top of the card stack. This sends white light through the cards, clearing them of old and lower energies.

Next, touch each card with your dominant hand. You can do this easily by pulling the first card from the top with your dominant hand, and then pulling each subsequent



card into this hand. As you touch each of the cards briefly, you're imbuing them with your personal energy. In this way, the cards get to know you.

When you're done touching each card, fan the cards out and hold them at the base. Bring the fanned cards to your heart, with the pictures facing you. Close your eyes and center yourself. Then, say your intentions and prayers for the cards, such as, "I ask that all of my readings with these cards be very accurate, specific, and healing. I ask for help in clearly hearing, seeing, knowing, and feeling the true underlying meaning of each card reading. Please help all of my readings to bring blessings to everyone involved."

Storing Your Cards

Your cards are sensitive tools, and they easily absorb energy. For that reason, it's best to store your cards appropriately. For instance, keep them in a beautiful velvet pouch, a carved wooden box, or some other special container. They can also be placed upon your altar to receive and send healing energy. Placing a clear



quartz crystal on top of the cards also has a protective effect. Additionally, you can visualize shielding the cards with a blanket of purple light.

Giving a Card Reading

To give yourself a reading, begin by thinking of a question while shuffling the cards. Call upon Heaven to help you clearly receive the answer to this question. Stop shuffling whenever you feel guided—don't worry, you can't stop shuffling at the wrong time. Then, pull three cards from the top of the deck and lay them out, with the first card to the left, the second card in the middle, and the third card to the right.

The card to your left speaks about your immediate past with respect to the question's topic. The middle card addresses your current situation, and the right-hand card gives you insight into the future outcome. If you change your thoughts and beliefs about the situation, it's possible to improve the outcome.

Read the cards while simultaneously checking in with your intuitive impressions. As you look at the cards, pay attention to the first



thing that comes to mind. Also notice your body's reaction to the cards. Your body is a profoundly accurate oracle device that speaks to you through emotional and physical feelings. The card paintings are also significant and may contain clues to your question's answer.

To give someone else a reading, have the person tell you his or her question. Think of that question while you shuffle the cards. As with a personal reading, check with your intuition as to when to stop shuffling. This intuition may come as an inner voice, a feeling, a sense, or a knowingness. After you stop shuffling, take three cards off of the top and lay them out, left to right, with the pictures facing you, the reader. Interpret them in the manner described above.

If the cards don't seem to directly answer the question, then ask whoever is receiving the reading if there was another underlying question that he or she was wondering about. The cards answer our true concerns, rather than the question that's posed. For instance, people may ask about their love lives when the real issue is financial security. The cards will zero in on abundance issues as the individual's fundamental interest.



While reading for someone else, you may wonder, *Is this reading really about me?* because the issues discussed may sound like your own. Many times, the information revealed in readings is both for you and your reading client. The information is still quite valid for your client, even though it may involve your own issues and situations.

You can ask the same question again for additional information and validation. Most of the time, you'll pick the same cards whenever the same question is asked. However, the card reading will eventually become muddy and unclear if the same question is asked persistently. If you need help in trusting the cards' answers, ask the goddesses to give you a clear sign that you've understood their guidance correctly.

Some of the cards have feminine, gender-specific messages, such as the cards *High-Priestess*, *Medicine Woman*, and *Sorceress*. If you're a man, or are reading for a man, please understand that these principles apply equally to both genders. In other words, there is goddess energy within each man. You can also rewrite the words so that they apply to their masculine versions (for example, High-Priest, and so on).



To give remote readings, use the cards in the same way as described above. You can give card readings for other people over the telephone, by e-mail, regular mail, or simply by tuning in to the other person. The person you're reading doesn't need to be physically present to assure the accuracy of the reading.

Variations on Oracle Card Readings

The ways in which you conduct oracle card readings are unlimited. Use your guidance and imagination to create new methods to work with these cards. Here are some examples of how you can use your *Goddess Guidance Oracle Cards* for guidance and inspiration:

— “*What do I need to know today?*” Ask this question in the morning as you shuffle the cards, then pull one card from the top. Keep this card visible all day to give you a talisman of inspiration.

— “*What do I need to know about this person?*” When asking about a person, shuffle the cards and pull a section of the card deck



upward. Look at the card at the bottom of the top stack that you pulled upward. Keep shuffling and pulling a portion of the card deck, looking at the same position of the card that's underneath the top section. These cards will give you a fluid, running narrative about a person. You can use this method while talking with someone on the telephone—it serves as a spiritual truth detector about the person's true character and motivations.

You can also answer any question through shuffling while thinking of that inquiry, and then pulling as many cards from the top as you feel guided to pull. You might hear, think, or feel the number “seven,” for instance. In this case, pull seven cards from the top of the shuffled cards. As before, place the first card to the left, and each subsequent card to its right. The first card reveals the basis of the situation and the issue that you've recently successfully dealt with. The second card discusses the current situation. The third card shows your immediate future, and each subsequent card to the right reveals the future in approximately three-month increments.



Multi-Card Readings

The *Goddess Guidance Oracle Cards* can be used in conjunction with my other oracle cards, as they're all from the same family of light and love. You can shuffle the *Goddess* cards in with my *Angel*, *Fairy*, or *Mermaid and Dolphin* oracle cards and receive detailed and accurate readings.

Or, do a reading with each card deck separately. Spread the cards out from left to right using the first deck. Then, do the same thing with the second deck, placing the spread immediately below that of the first card deck. Keep placing subsequent card spreads immediately below them.

Read the cards vertically. The first vertical line of cards gives you rich details with respect to the situation's immediate past. Look for the common thread between the cards in the first vertical line. Read them like a storyboard. Then, do the same for the second vertical set of cards, which shows details about the current situation. To determine the future outcome, read through the third vertical line of cards.



Jumping Cards

While you're shuffling the cards, one or more of them may "jump" out of the deck. Place the jumping cards faceup, next to your card spread. Jumping cards contain additional information for your reading, so take their messages into consideration.

Upside-Down Cards

If a card appears upside down to you, the card reader, this signifies a blockage in that area that needs addressing or healing. Everyone has blocks, so this is nothing to be afraid of or ashamed about. It simply gives insights into life areas that could use extra attention.

**“Which Goddess Is with Me?”
and “Which Goddess Would Be Best
for Me to Work With?”**

You can ask either question as you shuffle, and pull one or more cards to discover which goddesses you're aligned with, who are already



working with you, or who would be good for you to call upon.

Invoking the Goddesses

You don't need to be specially trained or "gifted" to call upon the goddesses for help or healing. They come to whoever sincerely calls upon them. One way is to hold the cards of the specific goddesses you wish to invoke. Or just think their names silently, say them aloud, or write them a letter in your journal. You can also ask the goddesses to give you a clear sign that they're with you (don't specify what the sign should be—allow them to surprise you in their creative ways). You'll soon feel and enjoy the goddesses' loving and powerful presence.



GENERAL MEANINGS OF THE CARDS

This guidebook will give you additional information about the cards' general meanings. The term *general meaning* is used purposely, as each time you give a reading the card meaning can shift. Each card should be interpreted in the context of the question that was asked. Read this booklet to gain additional ideas and insights into the cards' meanings; however, always consult your intuition as the ultimate authority about the true meaning of a card spread.

In the pages that follow, you'll find a channeled message from each goddess. You'll also read the "Various Meanings of This Card" section, which give concise interpretations of the cards' meanings. The cards' specific meanings change according to the question asked, as well as the other cards that are drawn. Read each meaning, and your mind or body will tell you which one applies. Reading these meanings could also trigger your recognition of some



other interpretation. Trust your gut and impressions as the ultimate authorities when interpreting these or other cards.

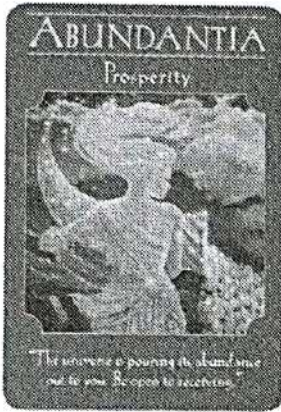

ABUNDANTIA

Prosperity

“The universe is pouring its abundance out to you. Be open to receiving.”



Message from Abundantia:

“Asking for help is a sign of strength, not weakness. You are very powerful, and I’m here to support your growing power. It’s right for you to receive this help, as we function as a team.

I’ve heard your prayers, worries, and affirmations. I’m pouring my cornucopia of prosperity upon you now, so expect unforeseen windfalls and gifts. Notice the new ideas, feelings, and visions within you. This guidance gives you clear direction about actions to take in conjunction with my assistance. Together, we’re unstoppable!”

Various Meanings of This Card: Be open to receiving • A new windfall of money is coming to you • You have nothing to worry about



- Your new venture will be financially successful
- Visualize and affirm abundance
- Abundance comes to you in many ways, including extra time, support, and ideas.

About Abundantia (pronounced *Ah-bun-DON-she-uh*): Abundantia is a beautiful Roman and Norse goddess of prosperity, success, and abundance who is said to bring good fortune and financial windfalls to all who call upon her. She carries a cornucopia of golden coins, which trail behind her wherever she goes. One sign that she's with you is that you'll find lots of spare change in unlikely locations. And rest assured that Abundantia brings more than pocket money to those who call upon her. She bestows all kinds of prosperity, including increased amounts of time, ideas, and other forms of support.



AERACURA

Blossoming

“You are just getting started, so have patience with yourself and the process, and do not give up.”



Message from Aeracura: “In many ways, you are like a flower bud who is ripe and ready to open and grow. Don’t try to rush this process, as it’s part of your beautiful path. Enjoy learning new knowledge and skills. Take your time to gather new ideas. Nurture your body with plenty of fresh air, sunshine, water, and healthful food. Soon enough, you’ll get the unmistakable signal that it’s time to put your learning into action. Spend time among flowers, or work with flower essences and oils to support your growth process.”

Various Meanings of This Card: Slow down • Have patience • Get involved with gardening



- Use aromatherapy and/or flower essences •
Keep the faith.

About Aeracura (pronounced *Air-uh-CURE-uh*): Aeracura is a Celtic and Germanic goddess who multitasks as an Earth Mother deity, a fairy queen, and also a bridge between earthly life and the hereafter. She helps us put our goals and challenges into perspective so that we don't needlessly stress ourselves. Call upon her for emergency money or help in manifesting supply. She's especially fond of assisting artists and inventors.



AINE

Leap of Faith

“Take a risk, and put your heart’s true desire into action!”



Message from Aine: “Procrastinating about your dreams won’t make them go away. Neither will it make them happen. Indecision is the death of the soul’s burning passion to improve, grow, and learn. Don’t worry about making a wrong decision. Instead, worry about making no decision at all! Then take time to pray, meditate, investigate, research, go on nature walks . . . and make your decision.

“Once made, the universal energies will immediately support your decision, and doors will successively open as if by magic. The magic, you see, is that you’ve set your mind to accomplish something. And this intention is what sets you on your magical journey. Trust that the universe will support you in all ways. Trust that your intention is clear and right for



you. And then take a leap of faith and jump fully and squarely into the midst of putting your dreams into action. Don't hesitate or delay a moment longer!"

Various Meanings of This Card: Your dream will come true • Your chosen path is the right one for you • Heaven supports you fully on your mission • Your material needs will be taken care of • Take action steps toward the realization of your dream • Break your dream into achievable baby steps so that it's easier to start and keep going.

About Aine (pronounced *AWN-ya*): Aine is a powerful Celtic goddess and fairy queen who gave birth to incarnated fairies from her romances with mortal men. Aine is revered in Ireland for helping to grow crops and oversee animals. You can call upon Aine when you need additional guidance and the courage to take risks.



APHRODITE

Inner Goddess

“Awaken the goddess within you through dance, self-care, and appreciating your divinity.”



Message from Aphrodite: “Allow your inner feminine wisdom and dynamic beauty to rise to the surface. Cherish its power and meaningfulness. No matter whether your physical body is male or female, you have an inner femininity that nurtures you, and guides you with its intuitive principles. Now is the time to become aware of, take excellent care of, and celebrate your magnificence!”

Various Meanings of This Card: Balance your male energy with more female energy • Take steps to heal your sexuality • Enjoy being feminine • Dance more often • Be receptive • In relationships, allow your softer side to come



forward • Don't hide your femininity (dress in a more feminine way, for example).

About Aphrodite (pronounced *Af-rob-DY-tee*): Aphrodite is the Greek goddess of passion and love, who's associated with the planet Venus. Aphrodite's name means "foam born," as legend says that she sprang from her father Uranus's castrated genitals, which were cast into the ocean. Thus, Aphrodite represents unabashed female sexual energy. Aphrodite helps women feel comfortable with their bodies and sexuality. She helps both genders to experience more passion in their relationships, and to become more balanced as far as individual male-female energy is concerned.



ARTEMIS Guardian

“You and your loved ones are safe and spiritually protected.”



Message from Artemis: “Like me, you have a sacred mission to spread love and light. Yet, this isn’t a position that comes from tension or worry. Instead, the gentle essence of a joyful heart and lighthearted laughter sets your power into motion. Why would there be any tension in your mind or system unless you believed that you were somehow unsafe? And how could you be unsafe when you’ve called upon the spiritual warriors to watch over you? Your prayers have activated the flawless protection of Heaven. So, ease your mind of all cares and concerns, and concentrate instead upon your holy mission.”

Various Meanings of This Card: The angels are watching over you and your family • Your



future is safe and secure • All your needs are being met and always will be • The worst is now behind you.

About Artemis (pronounced *AR-tem-is*): The Greek goddess Artemis is the twin sister of Apollo, the sun god. She's a powerful, tomboyish goddess who prefers to spend her time in the woods with wild animals. Artemis has carried a bow and arrow ever since they were given to her in childhood, yet she never uses them to hurt anything. Rather, the energy of her bow and arrow is a talisman that helps her focus her thoughts and intentions, and she always reaches the mark of her manifestations.

Artemis helps us concentrate and focus as well. She offers protection to all who call upon her, particularly women and children.



ATHENA

Inner Wisdom

“You know what to do. Trust your inner wisdom, and take appropriate action without delay.”



Message from Athena: “I’m happy to assist you; however, you’ll be most thrilled when you first consult your own inner bank of knowledge. For I assure you that this situation is already resolved and that you have access to all the wisdom that the universe supplies. To access this wisdom, you must quiet your mind. Surrender all worries and other concerns to the loving and almighty power of the universe. Close your eyes, and note the thoughts and feelings that come streaming into your consciousness. If you like, you can ask me to give you a signal that you’ve heard your inner wisdom correctly. But have faith. I assure you that you



have heard, and that the guidance brings you and your loved ones very good news indeed.”

Various Meanings of This Card: Stop procrastinating • Stop giving away your power to others • Trust your gut • Don't second-guess yourself • You are correct • Notice recurring ideas, and take action on them.

About Athena (pronounced *Uh-THEEN-uh*): Athena is a powerful and wise Grecian goddess who oversees and protects those who call upon her. She's the daughter of Zeus, and her power animals are white owls and black pigeons. Although Athena is a warrior goddess, she does battle with wits instead of weapons. You can call upon her for resolving disputes, and also for protection. In addition, Athena helps with creative projects such as writing, arts, and crafts.



BAST

Independent

“Your independence is a foundation for your strength and success.”



Message from Bast: “Like the cat, you’re fiercely independent, yet you also need affection and playful companions. Now is the time to balance your social interactions with solitude. While you may ask others for their opinions, ultimately you must make your own decisions. Your freedom and independence are top priorities, so ensure that these characteristics are nurtured.”

Various Meanings of This Card: Spend time alone • Give yourself permission to play • Ask for your needs to be met • Make your own decision • Work with cats • Pay attention to your pet feline and/or get a new cat.



About Bast (rhymes with *Mast*): The Egyptian goddess Bast transforms into a cat each night and protects her family and those who call upon her with her all-seeing night vision. She exhibits the catlike traits of the feminine, which include gracefulness, independence, playfulness, and intuition. Bast also works with cat lovers to help their feline companions. The daughter of the sun god, Ra, Bast has the rare distinction of being both a moon and a sun goddess.



BRIGIT

Don't Back Down

“Stand up for what you believe is right.”



Message from Brigit: “First, be quite clear about your intentions. If you’re unclear, then confusion will lessen your power and force. Like a candle in the dark, be very clear and bright in what is acceptable to you in this situation. Make no mistake: I will guide and protect you. And yet, think of the unparalleled rise in your own viewpoint if you are to stand up for yourself, and speak up about your needs and your deepest truth! Now is the time to touch your power, for its heat and flame will ignite your passion, which will propel you forward in countless ways. Even in the face of fear, you can still stand up for your ideals and your truth. Be unwavering, and make your stand today!”

Various Meanings of This Card: Be assertive • Don't worry about what others think • Trust



that your actions will work out fine • Speak your truth • Stick to your opinions • Put your foot down.

About Brigit (pronounced *BRIH-jet*): Brigit is a Celtic triple-goddess, which means that she represents three aspects of woman: the young virgin, the nurturing and loving mother, and the crone/sage/wise woman. Brigit is a fiery goddess who tirelessly protects those who call upon her, and she's a feminine counterpart to Archangel Michael's warrior energy. Brigit's temple is in Kildare, Ireland. She's celebrated worldwide on February 1, the ancient sacred day called "Imbolc," which marks the beginning of springtime and increasing daylight.



BUTTERFLY MAIDEN

Transformation

“You are experiencing enormous change right now, which brings great blessings.”



Message from Butterfly Maiden:

“As you go through this period of change, it’s natural for you to wonder if your future is safe. I’m here to assure you that you’re part of nature’s cycles of birth, death, and rebirth. To bring in your desired newness, you must first allow old parts of your life to fall away. These changes are to be celebrated, not feared. Give thanks for this shedding of the old! Embrace all of the lessons it brought, and then let it go! Be giddy with excitement at the newness of the gifts that are now being bestowed upon you, and let their magic surprise and delight you.”

Various Meanings of This Card: Don’t be concerned about endings, as they’re bringing in the new for you • Your prayers have been answered



with this change • Let go of the old • Don't worry about these changes—they're truly for the best.

About Butterfly Maiden: Butterfly Maiden is a Hopi Native American kachina (spirit) who ensures that crops yield healthy and bountiful harvests. She's a springtime goddess who helps us escape from any cocoon situation that's trapping us or impeding our growth or joy. If you're feeling stuck, she's a wonderful goddess to call upon during the emerging process. She'll also guide you through life transitions and help you spread your wings!



CORDELIA

Go Outside

“You have been indoors too long.
Go outside and get some fresh air.”



Message from Cordelia: “Being cooped up is not the natural way for inhabitants of this exciting planet to live. Believe me, there’s plenty to see and experience when you exit your four walls and roof. A daily venture outside will not only revive your spirit and soul, it will give you hope and faith in this planet’s very existence and future. You’ll see all of the goodness that’s in store within nature: the flowers ready to unfurl, the leaves that are sprouting, the birds that hop about, and even the wind that affectionately caresses you. Don’t let another day go by without stepping outdoors into this most entertaining and exciting of environments!”

Various Meanings of This Card: Your manifestation will appear in May and/or when the



weather is warmer • Spend time in nature • Change to a job that allows for more connection with nature • Practice environmentalism • Recognize the need for balance in your life—for more rest and play.

About Cordelia (pronounced *Cor-DEEL-ya*): This Celtic fairy goddess helps watch over the flowers that bloom in the spring and summertime. She's associated with the ancient sacred day, Beltane, which is celebrated on May 1 to welcome the Celtic summer season. Call upon Cordelia to help you thaw out any situation or relationship that seems cold and dreary.



COVENTINA

Purification

“It is time for a cleansing detoxification
of your body and mind.”



Message from Coventina: “This message comes as a help, and not as an affront or a criticism. Your vessel has become clogged by overuse of harsh chemicals, and the offending source is within your psyche. You’ve been ignoring your body’s many signals and screams for relief from the steady ingestion of impurities. Perhaps you’ve also noticed a slump in your energy level, and your degree of joy has lagged as well. Never mind these past effects, though, as the solution is at hand right now! Now that you’ve heard this message, do not hesitate for even a moment to make new arrangements. You’ll want to keep a sharp focus on the contents of your mind and speech as well, for the words you think and speak are the very diet



that supports or thwarts you. Choose purity, and I promise you a changed outlook for the better.”

Various Meanings of This Card: Follow your intuition’s guidance about making lifestyle changes • Stop abusing alcohol or drugs • Avoid processed foods such as sugar, white flour, and so on • Eat more organic foods • Keep your thoughts and speech positive • Adopt a vegetarian or vegan diet • Go on a fast or detox diet • (This card can also be a validation that your current healthful path is working.)

About Coventina (pronounced *Coh-ven-TEEN-ab*). She’s a powerful Celtic goddess of the waters, including the oceans, lakes, streams, ponds, and rivers. Coventina protects bodies of water and their inhabitants, and she’s happy to give you a Divine assignment related to environmentalism, if you ask her. Wishing wells were made in her honor, and today we continue the practice of throwing coins into water while making a wish. It’s Coventina who grants these wishes. Since our bodies are primarily made up of water, she’s very involved with helping us



purify our physical selves. She reminds us that purification also means keeping our thoughts and speech filled with positive words, which empower and strengthen our bodies and lives.



DAMARA

Guiding Children

“You are good at helping, counseling, and healing children. Use your skills to help children now.”



Message from Damara: “One can be gentle and a fierce protector simultaneously. My vigilant focus on keeping harmony within households stems from my desire for children to maintain their youthful awe and sense of wonder. How else will we ensure that they’ll see and speak with the fairies? How else will we foster the continuation of children’s healing laughter? Join with me in guiding the children, and you’ll see your own imagination sparked by these amazing young beings. Your own enthusiasm and youthful spirit attracts the children’s respect and attention. I’ll lead you toward young people who can benefit from your help.”



Various Meanings of This Card: Spend time with, or have a heart-to-heart talk with, your own children • Get into a career involved with helping kids • Volunteer with young people • Know that children will be coming into your life soon • You will be a parent • Take care of your own inner child through play and laughter.

About Damara (pronounced *Duh-MAR-uh*): A Celtic fertility goddess whose name means “gentle,” Damara helps to bring peace and harmony to families and within households. She helps children maintain their youthful innocence and faith. Damara is happy to guide you with respect to the best way to help children—yours or someone else’s.



DANA

High-Priestess

“You have Divine knowledge that can help others through your spiritual teaching.”



Message from Dana: “Your wisdom extends back into the far reaches of ancient times. 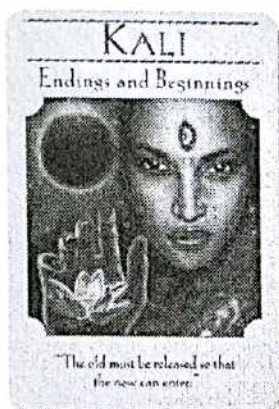

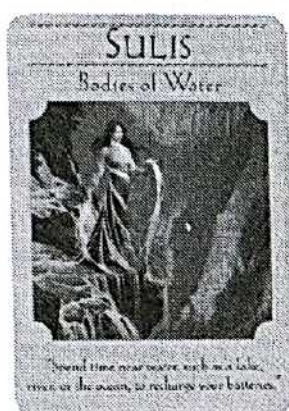

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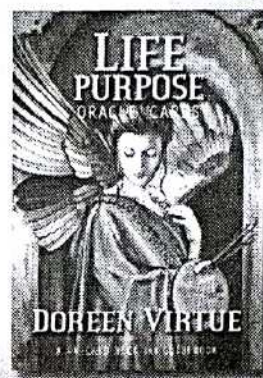
